Something has happened in the **past (specific time)** and **has finished**

I **lived** in Johor in 1994.

I **collected** stamps when I **was** a child.

I **took** her home just now.

They **were** at his birthday party last night.

The **cleaned** the house last weekend.

He **knew** the answer yesterday.

Once upon a time, a lord **lived** in the castle.

There **was** an ugly witch living in the middle of the forest.

In the past, the knights **travelled** on strong horses.
