Singular	Plural
The <u>pupil</u> <b>sings</b> during the music class.	The <u>pupils</u> <b>sing</b> during the music class.
<u>He / She</u> <b>prepares</b> some food for supper.	<u>They</u> <b>prepare</b> some food for supper.
The <u>child</u> <b>runs</b> around in the field.	The <u>children</u> <b>run</b> around in the field.
The <u>dog</u> <b>does</b> not like its new owner.	The <u>dogs</u> <b>do</b> not like their new owner.
The <u>backpacker</u> <b>has</b> no place to sleep tonight.	The <u>backpackers</u> <b>have</b> no place to sleep tonight.
<u>He</u> <b>is</b> a friend of mine	<u>They</u> <b>are</b> friends of mine.
