Verb	Present Tense	Past Tense	Example
to be	is am	was	<i>He <b>is</b> the head prefect.</i> <i>I <b>am</b> a boy.</i> <i>She <b>was</b> in Langkawi yesterday.</i>
	are	were	<i>These boys <b>are</b> my nephews.</i> <i>We <b>were</b> there last month.</i>
to have	has have	had	<i>She <b>has</b> a yellow raincoat.</i> <i>You <b>have</b> a dictionary.</i> <i>He <b>had</b> a football practice yesterday.</i>
to do	does do	did	<i>She <b>does</b> the housework every day.</i> <i>We <b>do</b> our work quietly.</i> <i>They <b>did</b> their homework just now.</i>
