| Why | To ask the reason for <br> something | Why are you here? <br> Why is the bag wet? <br> Why is he going out? <br> Why do you want to be a singer? |


| Whose | To ask about who the <br> owner of something <br> is / belong to <br> (possessives) | Whose pencil is this? <br> Whose ruler is this? <br> Whose car is that? <br> Whose books are these? |

| Where | To ask about places | Where are you? <br> Where is the ruler? <br> Where do you live? <br> Where is the car key? |
| When | To ask about the time <br> something happens | When is your brother's birthday? <br> When are we going home? <br> When did you come? <br> When will you leave? |
| How | To ask about the way <br> how something is <br> done / quality, <br> quantity | How are you? <br> How was your trip? <br> How do you cook the fish? <br> How do you get to London? |
